Request For Proposal (Mobile Applications Developer)

About Us:

Generations For Peace is implementing a pilot programme that responds to “the violence of exclusion” of youth in Jordan by enhancing youth employability through experiential soft and technical skills development of recent information and communications technology (ICT) graduates.

The programme will be featuring three apps developed by youth members in three communities. The apps will be developed using flutter and youth have been trained to be able produce and develop the applications.

Description of Role:

During the Code For Jordan Programme, young IT graduates are aiming to develop an application using Flutter to respond to their community’s needs. One application is being developed in three target communities: Mafraq, Amman, and Al-Salt. Leading to three applications (one in each community).

The role of the developer is to work along youth and develop the end products. Youth are already in the process of development receiving mentoring from ProgressSoft. Therefore, the role of the developer would be to further use his/her skills to contribute to the applications’ development and finishing. This would include enhancing UI/UX design, track applications defects, resolve any problems existing in the system and contribute to the designing and building of highly scalable apps. More details regarding the responsibilities are below.

Responsibilities:

- Maintaining software through product lifecycle including design, development, verification and bug fixes
- Ensure security guidelines are always followed while developing the app
- Manage the code and project on Git in order to keep in sync with other team members and managers
- Follow the best practices while developing the app and also keeping everything structured and well documented
- Resolve any problems existing in the system and suggest and add new features in the complete system
- Contribute to the designing and building of highly scalable apps using Flutter
- Detect and track applications defects and inconsistencies
- Work as part of a cross-functional team, which includes youth and fresh IT graduates across three governorates (Amman, Salt, Mafraq)
- Designing graphic user interface elements, like logos, menus, tabs and widgets
- Prepare deliverables per meeting with youth members who work on the development of the applications
- Prepare reports to Generations For Peace on progress made

Must Have:

- Flutter: To build cross platform mobile apps for Android, IOS and Web. This should include from making responsive UIs to efficiently query data and also manage states in an optimized manner.
- Native Android and IOS: To build custom Flutter Packages.
- Firebase: Should have experience with Cloud Firestore, Push Notifications, Cloud Functions and Analytics.
- Adobe XD: Should know how to use Adobe XD to use the design file and use it to build the app.
- Git: To manage and collaborate in different projects with the rest of the team.
- Have published one or more mobile apps in the Google Play/Apple store.
- Experience with third-party libraries and APIs.
- Understanding of the Agile development life cycle.

2. Cost
3. Timelines (ability to deliver the end products within GFP deadline **25th of February 2021**)
4. Experience and reputation
